## **2004 Olympic Assistant Coach Selection Policy**

### **Selection Committee**

The Assistant Coach for the 2004 Olympic Team will be selected by a five person committee consisting of the following individuals;

- Head Coach, Olympic Team (corresponding to the specific position – i.e. Freestyle Men's Head Coach for the Freestyle Men's Assistant position, etc.)
- Athletes' Representative (the Male Representative for both the freestyle and Greco Roman Men's Team Positions and the Female Representative for the Women's Team Position)
- National Program Director
- CAWA Vice-President Technical
- CAWA President

There are three Assistant Coach positions; Men's Freestyle, Greco Roman, and Women's Team positions. The selection must be ratified by the CAWA Executive Committee. In the event that Canada fails to qualify the required number of wrestlers in a given discipline (Freestyle, Greco and Women) required by the COC for an Assistant coach position, the related coach selection will be nullified.

### **PROCESS**

Any coaches interested in applying for the Assistant Coach position should send a covering letter and coaching resume c/o The National Program Director, CAWA, Unit #7, 5370 Canotek Road, Gloucester, Ontario, K1J 9E6. The application deadline is February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2003.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

The Assistant Coach for the Olympic Teams should possess the following qualifications;

- certified NCCP Level 4
- significant experience and success at the international level (i.e. World Championships, Major Games)
- demonstrated ability to develop and monitor training programs of high performance athletes
- demonstrated ability to work cooperatively with athletes, coaches and other support staff
- excellent communication skills
- ability to motivate and encourage team building
- commitment to the 2003 World Team Program and 2004 Olympic Team Program including the qualification events.
