

**SECTION 5.2**  
**NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**  
**ALLOCATION FORMULA**

## National Championships Allocation Formula

Based on an annual contribution of \$ 20,000 the National Championships allocation to the provinces and territories will be as follows:

Canadian Senior Championships	\$ 15,000
Atlantic Championships	3,000
N.W.T. Territories Trials	1,000
Yukon Trials	1,000

### 1. Senior Championships

Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia will receive funding for the Senior Canadian Championships.

The funding allocation is based on affiliation fees paid, performance in the previous year's senior national championships, and the cost to get to the host location from each province. The steps to determine the allocation are:

- 50% is based on the affiliation fee paid (column 1).
- 50% is based on the previous performance. The number of athletes placing in the top six in each weight class are tabulated (column 2).
- Total column 1 and 2 to determine the provincial totals (column 3).
- Eliminate the host province.
- Price the economy airfare for each province to travel to the host location (column 4).
- Multiply column 3 x 4 = (column 5).
- Determine the allocation percentage -  
$$\frac{\$ 15,000 \text{ contribution}}{\text{total required for total of column 5}}$$
- Determine the allocation for each province by multiplying the amount in column 5 by the allocation percentage. The total of the allocations to each province should equal \$15,000.

If the host province has an athlete who a) lives and trains more than 100 km from

the host location and b) placed in the top six at the previous senior national championships, the funding for that individual will be provided based upon the allocation percentage x the economy airfare.

## **2. Atlantic Championships**

Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island will receive funding for the Atlantic Championships. The steps to determine the funding allocation are:

- Eliminate the host province.
- Price the economy airfare for each province to travel to the host location (column 1).
- Total column 1.
- Determine the allocation percentage -  
$$\frac{\$ 3,000 \text{ contribution}}{\text{total required for total of column 1}}$$
- Multiply column 1 by the allocation percentage. The total of the allocations to each province should equal \$ 3,000.

## **3. Northwest Territories and Yukon**

The Northwest Territories and Yukon will each receive a contribution of \$ 1,000 for travel to their respective trials.

## **4. Admissible Expenses and Reporting**

Provinces and territories must submit original receipts for air, ground or sea travel only. The national championships allocation does not cover such expenses as meals and accommodations.

A list of participating coaches and athletes must accompany the receipts.

The national championships contribution does not cover expenses for referees or pairingmasters travel. This is allocated within the officials block for the senior national championships project.
